Purpose

The Family Center for Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (Family Center) is the statewide parent-directed center within Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS).

The Family Center is Michigan's prominent family-centered care initiative. Every state has a similar special health care program under Title V (Maternal and Child Health Services Block Grant) of the Social Security Act.

The primary role of the Family Center is to offer emotional support, information and connections to community-based resources to families of children and youth with special health care needs, including all children who have, or are at an increased risk for: physical, developmental, behavioral or emotional conditions. Children do not have to be enrolled in CSHCS to receive services from the Family Center.

The Family Center promotes coordinated systems of care that are family-centered, culturally competent and community-based by providing consultation related to programming, policies, direct family support initiatives, community education and collaborative partnerships.
