PURPOSE:

This training addresses the importance of recognizing a Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) in those with whom we live. FASD is often undiagnosed or misdiagnosed and is more common than Autism or Down Syndrome. Most children/youth with FASD look like their peers but their brain damage cannot be seen. Because of this, FASD is known as an invisible disability. Children/youth may display behaviors that repeatedly get them into trouble. Interventions are examined and strategies for improving outcomes for the child/youth, family, and programs that serve them are highlighted.

LEARNING OUTCOME:

After attending this training, the learner will be able to; define terms regarding the effects of prenatal alcohol exposure and identify structures of the brain that are affected by prenatal alcohol exposure. The learner will know the importance of screening and assessment for those who may have an FASD or other subtle cognitive impairments and be able to create a positive focused system of care. The learner will also be able to discuss the effects of misdiagnosis and co-occurring disorders on implementing interventions and know strategies to improve outcomes for individuals with an FASD and their families.
